1.0 GENERAL CONDITIONS

Sealed tenders in the form of two bid systems (Technical and Financial) are invited by High Commission of India, Nairobi from reputed companies for undertaking Geotechnical survey in connection with CONSTRUCTION OF STATE OF ART OFFICE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR HIGH COMMISSION OF INDIA at Muthaiga, Nairobi.

The tender should be submitted in prescribed format as laid down in the tender document. The tender documents duly filled in and complete in all respect should be addressed to the Head of Chancery Nairobi and are to be submitted offline only before 1500 hrs of 20th June 2022. Tenders or their representatives, who wish to be present during the tender opening, may do so. CHAPTER 1

1. Instructions to bidders

High Commission of India, Nairobi invites tender for undertaking Geotechnical survey in connection with CONSTRUCTION OF STATE OF ART OFFICE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR HIGH COMMISSION OF INDIA, NAIROBI at Muthaiga Nairobi.

The details of terms and conditions, schedule of work/ specifications and format for Technical and Financial bid are available in the tender documents. The bidders are instructed to go through tender form thoroughly before quoting their rates.

- 1.1 The tender is liable to be ignored if complete information is not given therein.
- 1.2 All bidders and/or representatives, if they so desire, may be present at the opening of the tender by the constituted committee at the time and date as specified in the schedule. It may be noted that under no circumstances tender received late shall be entertained.
- 1.3 Bidder are requested to submit their quotations/rates on one-time basis.

Price quoted should be in KES (Kenya Shillings) and should be inclusive of all costs except VAT. In no case any enhancement in approved rate will be entertained by the High Commission during the currency period of contract. Tenders not complete in this respect are liable to be ignored. The quotations shall be furnished in two covers i.e. Technical bids should be sealed in a separate cover while Financial bids be sealed in other over and super scribed as tender "Tender for undertaking Geotechnical survey in connection with CONSTRUCTION OF STATE OF ART OFFICE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR HIGH COMMISSION OF INDIA at Muthaiga Nairobi" Two separate covers will be sealed in the following manner: -

- (i) One cover containing the Technical documents (i.e. Annexure I duly filled in) includes documentary proof etc. (technical bid)
- (ii) Second cover containing rates and duration (i.e. Annexure II dully filled in) of this offer (Financial bid)
- 1.6 The agency, while submitting their tender form shall enclose self-attested photocopies of registration, surveying license and experiences essential for carrying out the activities under reference, and any other documents in support of permission from the Competent Authority for carrying out the activities under reference. Tender form incomplete in any respect and not supported with such requisite documents, will be rejected by this High Commission.

CHAPTER 2

2.0 Conditions of Contract

- 2.1 The contract, if awarded, from the date of award and extendable for further period subject to continuous satisfactory performance. However, on failure on this aspect by the service provider, the High Commission will have the right to terminate the contract forthwith.
- 2.2 The service provider shall not subject, transfer or assign the contract or any part thereof. In the event of the service provider contravening this condition, the High Commission will have the right to terminate the contract forthwith and the firm can be blacklisted by this High Commission.
- 2.3 The High Commission may at any time, by notice in writing, summarily terminate the contract without compensation to the survey company in any form in case it is felt by this High Commission that the bidder's work has not been satisfactory or in any other event where the firm is facing some legal problems which may affect their performance working in this High Commission. The decision of this High Commission shall be final in this regard.
- 2.4 In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the contracts, such dispute or difference shall be referred by either party to the Arbitration.
- 2.5 The Competent Authority reserves the right to reject any or all tender without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 2.6 After evaluation of the Technical bids, the Financial bids of only the technically qualified bidders shall be opened for arriving at L1 bidder.
- 2.7 In case of failure of the service provider/firm to comply with the provision of terms and conditions mentioned in this Tender documents or the agreement to be signed between High Commission and the successful Bidder, the Competent Authority of this High Commission reserves the right to terminate the contract and to blacklist the firm.
- 2.8 The survey company /agency shall be responsible for the specified undertaking Geotechnical survey in connection with CONSTRUCTION OF STATE OF ART OFFICE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR HIGH COMMISSION OF INDIA at Muthaiga Nairobi.

- 2.9 The survey company/ agency will be responsible for compliance of all laws, acts and rules made there under, statutory orders issued from time to time in relation to the environment and man-power deployed by them for performance of the job under reference and the High Commission will have a right to be indemnified in respect of any consequences resulting from any breach or violation by the survey company of such rules, statutory obligations etc.
- 2.10 In the event of any violation of the laws, rules. Statutory provisions by the survey company, this will amount to breach of contract and in such case, the High Commission will have the right for terminating the contract, forthwith, without giving any notice or assigning any reason.
- 2.11 This High Commission reserves the right to terminate this contract in any eventuality, without any notice and without explaining any reasons to the survey company. The survey company shall not have claim for any compensation in such event of discontinuation of the contract.

CHAPTER 3

3.0 Eligibility Criteria

- 3.1 The bidder should be a company/firm duly registered with the concerned authorities in Nairobi Kenya. It should have a permanent place of business in Nairobi. The complete postal address, telephone/ mobile/email address etc. should be provided, while submitting the completed tender form.
- 3.2 The survey company should have experience in having successfully completed similar works during the last 5 years


2.0 TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR SUBSOIL INVESTIGATIONS

1. GENERAL

There are plans to undertake a construction development on a property located at along Limuru road. The new project will consist primarily two main blocks. Facilities inside the development will include; auditoriums, halls, offices, stores, classrooms, and basement parking. A Geotechnical Investigation is required to determine the ground conditions.

a. Location of the Site

The site is located along Limuru road, across the road from High Commission of Ukraine in Kenya. See the attached image of the direction of the site from Nairobi Central Business District.



A formal Site visit shall be arranged or facilitated by the Client,

It is mandatory the Geotechnical Contractor visit the Site before submitting their bid.

b. Standards

The work shall be carried out in conformity with the provision of the latest relevant British Standard (BS) Codes and Standards. Relevant American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) shall be followed where BS Codes and Standards are silent.

2.2 OBJECTIVES OF THE INVESTIGATION

The objectives of the investigation will include the following:

- 1. To determine the allowable bearing pressure across the site
- 2. To assess and propose the most appropriate foundation depth, type, and size
- 3. To assess the suitability of the site for the proposed engineering works
- 4. To foresee and provide against difficulties that may arise during construction owing to the ground and other local conditions
- 5. To enable an adequate and economical design to be prepared.

2.3 SCOPE OF WORKS & DESCRIPTION

The Subsoil Investigation will include the following:

- 1. Sinking of $2N^{\Omega}$. Borehole and $8N^{\Omega}$. Trial Pits to a depth of 30 meters and 2.5 meters to rock respectively. (See attached Site Plan Drawing for Proposed Boreholes and Trial Pits Locations).
- Carry out SPT and/or DCP tests as per BS Standards and collect disturbed/undisturbed soil samples at specified intervals or as directed by the Consultant.
- 3. Collect rock core samples from the boreholes and determine the Rock Quality Designation (RQD), if, hard rock is encountered during drilling.
- 4. Conduct the following laboratory tests on samples recovered:
 - i. Particle size analysis.
 - ii. Atterberg Limits
 - iii. Determination of Natural Moisture Content
 - iv. Determination of Maximum Dry Density/Optimum Moisture Content.
 - v. Unconfined Compression Tests and density of rock
 - vi. Unconsolidated undrained Triaxial tests
 - vii. Chemical tests Sulphate and chloride content and pH of soil
 - viii. California Bearing Ratio (CBR)
- 5. Monitor water regime.
- 6. Submit factual geotechnical investigation reports along with borehole and trial pits location plan, detailed laboratory, and field test results with appropriate graphs/plots, and pertinent information required by this specification.


2.4 DETAILED REPORT

On completion of all field and laboratory testing, a detailed report shall be prepared and submitted to the Supervising Consultant and/or Client. The report shall include (but not by way of limitation):

- 1. A plan showing the position of all boreholes and trial pits at a particular location with georeferenced coordinates.
- 2. A description of the procedures of Investigation and testing employed and a list of equipment used.
- 3. Detailed borehole and trial pit logs, subsoil sections, laboratory, and field test results both in tabular as well as in graphical form, showing variations of each of the soil properties with depths in each borehole.
- 4. Field and laboratory test results along with graphs and tables used for computation.
- 5. The stress-strain diagrams as well as Mohr circle envelopes for unconfined compression tests, triaxial tests, and crushing strength of rock sample.
- 6. Modulus of elasticity calculated from the crushing strength of rock.
- 7. Recommendation regarding the type of cement to be used and any treatment to the concrete based on the chemical composition of soil and sub-soil water.
- 8. Any other Information of special significance encountered during the Investigation and likely to have a bearing on the design and construction of foundations.
- 9. Full colour photographs of field and laboratory activities and all the core boxes shall be included in each copy of the report.

A draft copy of the detailed report shall be submitted to the Supervising Consultant and/or Client for review and approval in soft copy and the final report shall be submitted thereafter in **three full colour copies**.
