The Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India through the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) has announced scholarship for foreign scholars for under-graduate, post-graduate & Ph.D courses in **Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy (AYUSH) courses** (traditional Indian System of Medicine) under "International Fellowship Programme" 2020-21.

2. Interested eligible Kenyan and Somali nationals are advised to register and apply online on **A2A student portal**: www.a2asholarships.iccr.gov.in by filling in prescribed application form. Physical Fitness Form available on this portal under guideline link must also be filled by a registered doctor from a government hospital and uploaded during application process.
3. After a candidate has submitted application online, he/she must download duly filled application form and forward it to High Commission of India on email education.nairobi@mea.gov.in and a copy to com.nairobi@mea.gov.in along with certified copies of academic certificates. The **last date** for receipt of applications is **25th July 2020**
4. Candidate should have attained the age of 18 years.
5. If selected, candidates will be provided with accommodation within the University and request for private accommodation will not be entertained.
